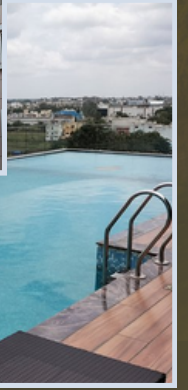

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## JAGDALPUR, CHHATTISGARH

Jagdalpur, located in the Bastar district of Chhattisgarh, is a city known for its deep historical roots and tribal heritage.

The city served as the capital of the ancient Bastar princely state, which was founded in the 14th century by Annam Dev, a ruler from the Kakatiya dynasty of present-day Telangana. The Bastar kings ruled the region for centuries, leaving behind a legacy of rich culture and tradition. After India's independence, the princely state was merged into the Indian Union in 1948. Jagdalpur is widely recognized for its harmonious blend of tribal traditions, royal history, and natural splendor. It continues to be a center for tribal culture, known especially for the grand Bastar Dussehra festival, which reflects the deep connection between the tribal people and their spiritual heritage.



**CHITRAKOTE WATERFALLS**

Chitrakote Waterfalls, often referred to as the "Niagara Falls of India," is one of the most spectacular natural wonders of Chhattisgarh. Located about 38 km from Jagdalpur, the waterfall is formed by the Indravati River and plunges from a height of nearly 30 meters in a wide, horse-shoe shaped arc. The falls are especially majestic during the monsoon season when the water volume increases significantly, creating a thunderous roar and misty spray. Surrounded by lush forests, Chitrakote is not only a scenic destination but also a sacred site for the locals, who believe the river and surrounding area to be blessed.



**TIRATHGARH WATERFALLS**

Tirathgarh Waterfalls, situated approximately 35 km from Jagdalpur, is another gem of Bastar's natural landscape. These cascading waterfalls drop in multiple tiers from a height of nearly 300 feet and are located within the Kanger Valley National Park. Unlike Chitrakote, Tirathgarh offers a more intimate experience, with natural rock formations and pathways allowing visitors to get close to the cascading water. The area around the falls is serene and picturesque, ideal for picnics and nature walks. It is also spiritually significant, with a temple dedicated to Lord Shiva situated nearby, attracting pilgrims and tourists alike.



**DANTESHWARI TEMPLE**

Danteshwari Temple, in Dantewada, is one of the 52 Shakti Peethas in India & holds immense religious importance. The temple is dedicated to Goddess Danteshwari, the presiding deity of the Bastar region & the Kuldevi of the Bastar royal family. Built in the 14th century, the temple stands at the confluence of the Shankini & Dhankini rivers & is made of stone in traditional South Indian style. It is the spiritual epicenter of the famous Bastar Dussehra, during which the goddess's idol is ceremonially brought to Jagdalpur. The temple not only serves as a sacred shrine for devotees but also as a symbol of Bastar's enduring spiritual legacy.
